WHO:

You must be a US citizen and by Election Day, you must be at least 18 years old and have lived in the county at least 30 days.

WHEN:

You can use "Same Day Registration" only in the Early Voting Period from 19 to 3 days before an Election, *but not on Election Day*.
When: OCT. 16 to NOV. 1 for Nov. 4 election.

HOW:

1. Go to an Early Voting Site in your county*
2. Fill out the registration form
3. Show one of these documents with your name and your current address:

- ▶ NC driver's license
- ▶ An electric, gas, phone, water, or cable bill
- ▶ Bank or bank-card statement
- ▶ Paycheck or paycheck stub or W-2 form
- ▶ Student ID & school document with your address
- ▶ A document from a government agency, such as
 - ◆ car registration, tax bill, license to hunt, fish, etc.
 - ◆ Social Security, Medicare, Medicaid card or letter
 - ◆ military ID, passport, other government ID
 - ◆ letter, invoice, etc., from any government agency
